## Uniforms:

- The 166 uniforms have been ordered. We should be getting them around the beginning to middle of August.
- All of the dresses and tuxes that were being hemmed are back, so they're ready for tomorrow.
- Thanks to Carmi for doing Janeen's job tomorrow as she is unable to attend.
- We need to seriously thinking about hats next year since most of the remaining ones are too small, but we don't have to make a final decision until April, so compiling prices would be handy.
- Hopes that plumes have been discussed and whatever happens next year is ultimately the directors' decision.
- Raincoats desperately need to be replaced as they are gross. However, they possibly may benefit from a proper washing. It takes a while to actually clean them, so we may ask volunteers to aid in this.

#### **Events:**

- We have the maps and trifold hand-out for the volunteers. The students' numbers are looking good, but the parents' numbers are poor. Adult volunteers helping set-up should be here by 3 on the 9<sup>th</sup>.
