- Only the parade is left. After that, the uniforms need to be dry cleaned. The dry cleaner will be
 picking up the uniforms in batches since he needs to clean both the pants and jackets. He needs
 dates when they can be picked up and will price it himself. The new Uniform Committee will
 have to decide the dates.
